## **How to use the Driver Assessment Form**

- Initially just circle driving faults to be discussed with the driver "Coasting / Riding / Slipping /Jerky"
- Discuss these faults with the driver and/or prompt as necessary
- During the actual assessment, use the 'X or /' column: X for major faults or / for minors and you may underline fault to identify as markable <u>"Coasting / Riding / Slipping /Jerky"</u>
